

### Qualifications to Apply

- have completed one college preparatory math courses (usually Algebra I or Geometry)
- have a 3.5 or higher GPA in math courses
- have a 3.0 or higher GPA overall

### Qualifications to be Active/Active + Member

PHUHS Mu Alpha Theta requires that members complete certain requirements in order to be considered active. Active members can vote in elections, but not run for any positions besides lower board. Only active (+) members are allowed to run for upper board positions. Only Active Members can attend the State Convention.

- Must attend at least one FAMAT competition.
- Must tutor at least once per semester.
- 35 points are required for active membership.
- 45 Points are required to be active + and to run for a board position.

### Membership Points

- 1 point - attending a general meeting
- 1 point - attending a board meeting
- 1 point - attending a practice
- 3 point - doing a practice test (must show work and send to your division coaches within three weeks of following competitions)
- 1 point - attending an hour of scrapbooking
- 1 point - attending an hour of tutoring (limited to 5 possible points per semester)
- 1 point – for every two times attending a Rubik’s cube meeting (max of 5 points per semester)
- 1 point - spending one hour or one period volunteering on behalf of the club (tutoring, scoring, filling out scantrons, etc.)
- 1-3 point(s) - taking photos at a competition (points awarded depends on quality of photos)
- 3 points - attending an in-school competition (such as the Dostal-Nunn, Log 1, or AMC)
- 3 points - attending a regional competition
- 10 points – placing at a regional or in-school competition
- 5 points - attending a statewide competition
- 15 points – placing at a statewide competition
- 10 points - attending the state convention\*
- 25 points - attending the national convention\*

\*or have signed up and/or paid to attend if final points are determined before these competitions
